His work with the Attractions earned him entry into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame, but the U.K. native followed that early pop success with a dizzying variety of projects, from chamber pieces with the Brodsky Quartet, collaborations with American legends Burt Bacharach and Allen Toussaint, the acclaimed Sundance Channel series *Spectacle*, and the recent Nashville-inflected sounds of 2009's *Secret, Profane and Sugarcane*. 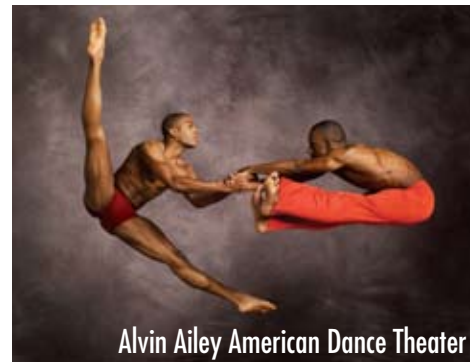
