Lone Twin Cyclists Explore 30 Days in the Life of Davis

Davis, Calif.—The **Robert and Margrit Mondavi Center for the Performing Arts** presents “**To the Century**” with the dynamic duo that forms **Lone Twin: Gregg Whelan and Gary Winters**, who, as part of the **UC Davis Centennial celebration**, will document **30 Days in the Life of Davis** via **daily tour by bicycle**, a vehicle that continues to have a tremendous influence in and around Davis.

Every day from **Friday, March 20, through Saturday, April 18**, Lone Twin will depart from the **Mondavi Center** at approximately **10 a.m.** for a five- to six-hour bike ride around Davis and the surrounding area, observing and collecting stories about the community. Following each day’s ride at **5:30 p.m.**, Whelan and Winters will present a live performance piece in **downtown Davis** at the **E Street Plaza** (between Second and Third Streets), with each piece building on that of the previous evening’s up until the final cumulative performance.

Says **Don Roth**, Mondavi Center executive director, “What could be more perfect to celebrate our region—Davis and UC Davis—than bike-based theatre? When we heard about Lone Twin’s “To the Century,” we knew we’d found our hallmark Centennial event, a theatre piece that grows out of the daily bicycle meanderings of our two actors. Join them on the road or by the stage—you’ll be part of a unique, once-a-century, only-in-our-town and -region, happening!”

Formed in 1997, **Lone Twin** makes art that playfully addresses travel, context and orientation. Committed to creating entertaining, hopeful works that are both challenging and rewarding, Whelan and Winters’ presentations range from context-specific events lasting many days to gallery, studio and stage shows.
